



Wharewaka looks out to the beautiful Wellington waterfront through a gleaming double glazed facade manufactured utilising Sikasil structural glazing silicone.

Wharewaka o Poneke in Wellington was officially opened on Waitangi day 2011. The striking building stands proudly on the waterfront near Taranaki Street Wharf and Te Papa, and is a central venue for exhibitions, meetings and functions. The \$11.5 million Wharewaka (meaning boat house), accommodates and displays two historical Waka and was also the centre for Wellingtons 2011 Rugby World Cup "fan zone".

The glass façades of the Wharewaka are a feature which takes full advantage of the beautiful waterfront surroundings. The glazing system installed by Ultra Glass Company Wellington incorporates a four-sided structurally glazed finish using Sikasil SG-500-CN (for its structural and weather tight performance), together with high performance glass types and double glazing spacer systems to produce a flush frameless façade appearance.
