All technical data stated in this Product Data Sheet are based on laboratory tests. Actual measured data may vary due to circumstances beyond our control.

LIMITATIONS

- Freshly applied Sikafloor®-21 PurCem® FG should be protected from damp, condensation and water for at least 24 hours.
- To ensure the finished system remains fully bonded to the substrate, it is recommended that retaining slots of 5 mm deep by 5 mm wide are cut into the substrate, running at 150 mm from and parallel to the walls and all edges, for example floor drains.
- Retaining slots are also recommended at day joints.
- Always ensure good ventilation when using Sikafloor®-21 PurCem® FG in a confined spaces.

Ensuring Consistent Colour Matching

 For consistent colour matching make sure the product in each area is applied using the same batch of colour packs

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

SUBSTRATE QUALITY / PRE-TREATMENT

The concrete substrate must be sound and of sufficient compressive strength (minimum 25 MPa) with a minimum pull-off strength of 1.5 MPa.

The substrate must be dry and free of all contaminants such as oil, grease, coatings and surface treatments, etc. If in doubt, apply a test area first. Concrete substrates should be prepared mechanically using abrasive blast cleaning or scarifying equipment to remove cement laitance and achieve a profiled open texture surface.

Weak concrete must be removed and surface defects such as blow holes and voids must be fully exposed. Repairs to substrate, filling of blow holes / voids and surface levelling must be carried out using appropriate products from the Sikafloor®, Sikadur® and Sikagard® range of materials.

High spots can be removed by grinding. All dust, loose and friable material must be completely removed from all surfaces before application of the product, preferably by brush and/or vacuum.

MIXING

Prior to mixing, stir Part A (resin) well, then add all of Part B (hardener) and mix both liquid parts thoroughly with a low speed electric stirrer for a minimum of one minute until a uniform mix has been achieved. Use a low speed drill (500 rpm) and a helical mixer to mix Sikafloor®-21 PurCem® FG Parts A and B. Gradually add Part C (aggregate) to the mixed resin parts in the mixer for a further 3 minutes minimum, until a uniform moist mix is obtained.

APPLICATION

Prior to application, confirm substrate moisture content, r.h. and dew point are within limits of application.

Pour the mixed Sikafloor®-21 PurCem® FG onto the substrate and spread evenly with a trowel or rake to the required levels, achieving a flat surface. Light spike rolling should be carried out within 3 minutes of application in order to avoid interfering with the film gel time.

CLEANING OF TOOLS

Clean all tools and application equipment with water immediately after use. Hardened or cured material can only be mechanically removed.
