- Bucket with rollers
- Grout finishing tool

#### **MIXING**

- 1. Follow the mixing ratio of 1:100, for example, 50 g of Product to 5 litres of water.
- 2. Measure out the Product and pour into a bucket of clean water.
- 3. Stir manually using a clean tool.

# **Protect the Product from moisture**

Preconditions

Observe information such as waiting times in the Product Data Sheet of the joint grouting product.

- 1. Use a sponge float to wash the surface of the tiles.
- 2. IMPORTANT Rinse the sponge and change the wash water frequently. Remove any smears or remaining haze.
- 3. Allow the surface to dry.
- 4. Repeat the cleaning process if there is any remaining epoxy grout haze.

#### **CLEANING OF TOOLS**

Clean all tools and application equipment with water immediately after use. Hardened material can only be removed mechanically.
